

Crew Member Job Description

- Hold a valid CRB, safeguarding certificate and first aid qualification
- Be prepared to join the AAC SAS and abide by the scouting rules.
- Wear the site uniform when working on site.
- Inform the site manager 3 months prior to any of your certificates expiring.
- Help with site maintenance during your weekends
- Help to run activities, making sure you are qualified to run the activity you are asked to run.
- Be available on site for your weekends or agreed times.
- Support the duty warden and site manager at all times.
- Report any concerns to the duty warden or site manager.
- Supervise junior crew keeping within the scouting policies, be familiar with the scouting yellow card and adhere to it.
- Be polite and helpful to campers at all times, making sure they are happy and safe.
- Keep site, toilets and crew block clean throughout the weekend and at the end of your weekends.
- Approach visitors if your duty warden is busy.
- Keep your duty warden informed if you can or can't make a weekend.
- Help your duty warden with all tasks that are required.
- Attend any training sessions as requested by the site manager.
- Come to an agreement with your duty warden with regards to supply and cost of meals over each weekend.
- Be a good role model for other crew and campers.
